## Access Statement

Situated in Southern Snowdonia in Mid Wales the Corris Craft Centre includes 9 individual Craft Studios; octagonal shaped pods bursting with creativity! There's lots of opportunities for hands-on fun too, a surprisingly great way to unwind and have some fun with your own clever creations to take home.

## Access

There is ample free car parking with designated blue badge spaces within a few yards of the main reception.

The Craft Centre and each of the 9 studios are fully accessible to wheelchair users. The Y Crochan Café and Bwtri Welsh food and drink shop are fully accessible via a ramp located at the entrance closest to the car park. There are also steps with a supporting handrail up to the Y Crochan café and Bwtri. The Staff are approachable and friendly and we encourage all visitors to approach them if they need assistance. All of the Craft Studios, the Café and Bwtri are happy to welcome guide dogs.

The individual craft studios, Y Crochan café and Bwtri are connected by flat paving slabs. Most of the area is flat with slight rises in two areas.

## With Added Fun.....

The Craft Centre Studios offer visitors the unique opportunity to get hands on experiences such as chocolate making, pottery painting, candle dipping and making your own herbal remedies. The studios endeavour to make the hands on activities available for all. It is advisable however, that if you have specific needs, to contact the studio directly and they can answer any questions or concerns you may have. ## Toilet Facilities:

Disabled toilets for both men and women are available together with baby changing facilities. There is room for a wheelchair in the disabled toilet but limited space for a carer.

We also have a Changing Places (high dependency unisex disabled toilet) unit on site which is accessible 24 hours a day with a RADAR key. Please ask at the Tourist Information Point nearest to the car park or the Y Crochan cafe if you require access to the changing places toilet without a key (during operational hours only).

## Dogs

Corris Craft Centre is dog friendly, we ask however that all dogs are kept on leads at all times. There are also dog waste bins on site which you are asked to use. The Craft Studios are dog friendly, however during the busy summer period we ask visitors with dogs to confirm access with the studio workers, as space inside may be limited.

We regret that, in the interests of food hygiene, we do not allow dogs, other than assistance dogs, into Y Bwtri, Y Crochan Café and Chocablock where food is prepared and served.

## Play Area

There is a small children's play area consisting of a small climbing wall, slide, fireman's pole and a sit on springer. There are also 2 swings. The play area is flat with rubber matting surrounding the play equipment.

## Our Attractions

We have 3 visitor attractions on site:

King Arthur's Labyrinth, Corris Mine Explorers and Lost Legends of The Stone Circle.

Lost Legends of The Stone Circle is a simple flat maze with gravel pathways, with only a slight rise at its centre. The pathways are wide enough to enable access for wheelchairs, prams and buggies. There are 8 mythical stories hidden around the simple maze to be found and enjoyed. There is a resting area at each story consisting of a wooden bench. The stories can be enjoyed in Welsh or English. The maze covers approximately 2500 metres<sup>2</sup>.

King Arthur's Labyrinth and Corris Mine Explorers are both underground attractions and located in the disused workings of an old Welsh Slate mine.
